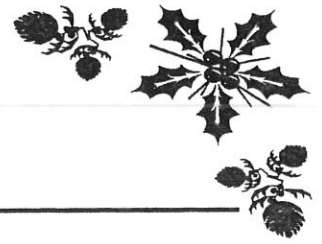
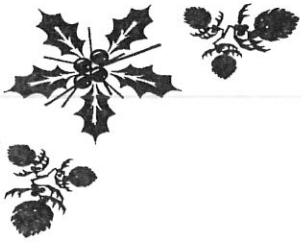

EXAMPLE: It is about Peter Rabbit making a bad choice.

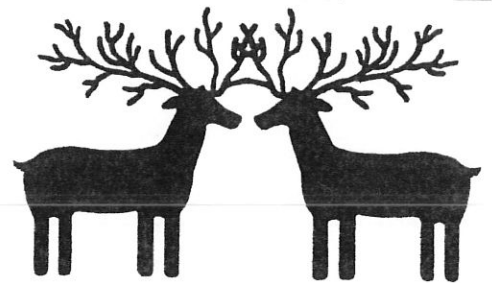
4. In the next section, tell why you think the person you are writing to would like this book. Give a GOOD reason. This sentence has also been started for you. You just need to finish it.
