1. What is the main idea of your report?
2. What is your mission's name?
3. What does your mission's name mean? (if is has one)
4. Who was your mission named for?

(Written Report – Paragraph 2)

5. Where is your mission located (what city, or by what city- I don't need the mailing address)?
6. What year was your mission built?
7. Who was responsible for building this mission?
8. What number mission is it (#1-21)?
9. What is your mission made of?

(Written Report – Paragraph 3)

10. What kinds of crops were grown? What type of vineyards? What did they do with their crops and vineyards?
11. What animals were at the mission? What did they do with the animals?
12. What would a day at the mission be like?
13. If you are a girl, describe what you would do if you were an Indian girl at your mission back then. What are your responsibilities? If you are a boy, what would you do back then? What are your responsibilities?
14. Describe what the workers (Indians and Priests) ate while at the mission for their meals.

(Written Report – Paragraph 4)

15. What difficulties did the mission face? Was the weather bad? Was the soil bad? Was there a lot of illnesses? Were there fires? Earthquakes? Indian raids?
16. When was your mission restored if at all?
17. Is there anything special about your mission? This can often be the best part of the report, taking you off on interesting topics.

(Written Report – Paragraph 5- closing)

18. Restate what your paper was about and give your final thoughts about your mission. What was interesting about your mission, did you like learning about it, would you like to go there?
