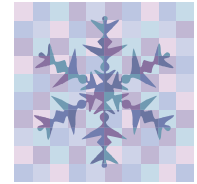


# MRS. DALLENBACH'S FRIDAY FACTS

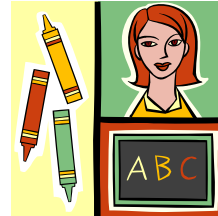
