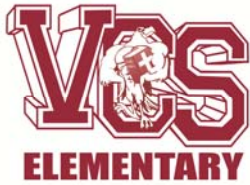
TARDY INFORMATION

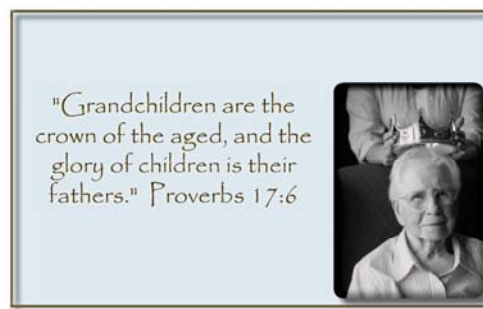

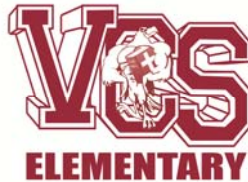
