Re-Enrollment for Returning Students

Re-enrollment packets will be distributed to all students, by their teachers, on Thursday February 16, 2012. Re-enrollment begins Tuesday, February 21, 2012. If you do not receive a re-enrollment packet, please contact the School Registrar at ext. 3020.

Priority Re-Enrollment is from February 21st to March 15th, 2012. New students will be accepted starting March 15th. To ensure your enrollment slot and preferred electives, please make sure that your re-enrollment paperwork is turned in by March 16, 2012. For families taking advantage of **PRIORITY** re-enrollment for grades K-12th, we are offering a payment plan option for each student.

Re-Enrollment begins February 21, 2012
Priority re-enrollment Deadline is March 16, 2012

PRIORITY RE-ENROLLMENT DUE BY MARCH 16, 2012

FEE: \$195.00 payable in three payments of \$65 each/ per student.

First payment WILL NOT be billed and must be received on or before March 15, 2012 4:30pm with COMPLETE re-enrollment packet.

The remaining two payments of \$65 each/per students are due in April and May, and will be billed to your SMART tuition accounts.

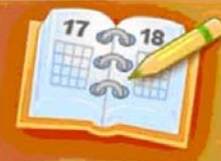

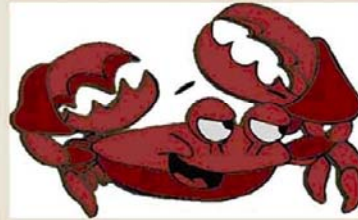
