Re-Enrollment for Returning Students

Re-enrollment packets will be distributed to all students, by their teachers, on **Thursday February 16, 2012**. Re-enrollment begins Tuesday, February 21, 2012. If you do not receive a re-enrollment packet, please contact the School Registrar at ext. 3020.

Priority Re-Enrollment is from February 21st to March 15th, 2012. New students will be accepted starting March 15th. To ensure your enrollment slot and preferred electives, please make sure that your re-enrollment paperwork is turned in by March 16, 2012. For families taking advantage of **PRIORITY** re-enrollment for grades K-12th, we are offering a payment plan option for each student.

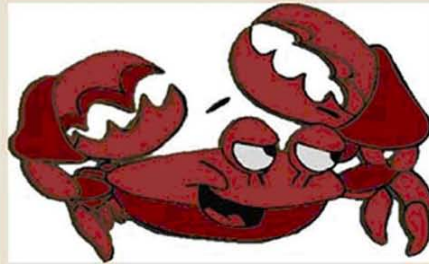
