FAFSA – California Student Aid for College
Cal-Grant Applications / Verification of GPA**

FAFSA is Free Application for Federal Student Aid

Seniors and their Parents will most likely want to go on the FAFSA website and fill out the necessary paperwork to apply for federal student aid for college. Both the student and the parents will need to register for a PIN that is used as an electronic signature. The federal (and free) website is: <http://www.fafsa.ed.gov/>. After you get your PINs back, you will want to complete a FAFSA Application. FAFSA is used

by most colleges as a part of their Financial Aid programs.

FAFSA deadline for the state of CA is March 2, 2012.

The Cal-Grant Deadline for submission is March 2, 2012. There is a Cal-Grant GPA Verification form that has to be signed by the parent and brought into the HS office. Please do not wait till the last minute.

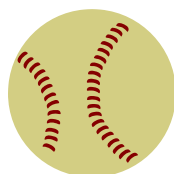

Practice will be Monday-Friday 3-5:30ish.

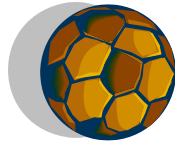
